I have lived in the San Fernando Valley for over 46 years. I currently live in Los Angeles County District No. 3. This District is also home to the Santa Monica Mountains and the North Santa Monica Bay. In 1991 our community elected Zev Yaroslavsky as Supervisor because he recognized the necessity to preserve these areas. If the proposed redistricting plans (either T1 or S2) are adopted, and this area becomes part of a community that doesn't understand the importance of preserving these areas, great irreversible damage could be done. Please reject maps T1 and S2. We strongly oppose this. Maps T1 and S2 would carve up and relocate over 1 million people and displace 3.5 million people, which is about 37% of the County's population. If we are forced into the 4th District which is an urbanized, dense, industrialized part of the county which shares little in common with the wildlands of our Santa Monica Mountains, we run the real risk of being dominated by industrial and urban uses. We do not belong in the same district.

We voted for Supervisor Yaroslavsky who represents the 3rd District and who will continue to represent the priorities of protecting the Santa Monica Mountains' unique contribution to the county and state.

When the current 3rd District lines were drawn in 1991, we finally had the ability to elect a Supervisor who would stand up to outside interests and say, "Let the land dictate the use."

I formally request you to adopt A3 and allow the relationships our Supervisor and our communities have created over the years to continue to thrive and flourish. Our community has dealt with fire and floods, and through the Supervisor's understanding of the mountain environment; many programs for safety have been established.

Prior to the 1991 redistricting, Our mountain communities did not have a Supervisor who understood our community's priorities to protect and preserve the Santa Monica Mountains for all to enjoy, not for a select few to destroy and develop.
