The Topanga Creek Watershed Committee urges the Citizens Redistricting Committee to keep our unincorporated community of about 10,000 residents connected within the boundaries of the 3rd Supervisorial District to our surrounding neighbors, Santa Monica, Pacific Palisades, Malibu, Calabasas, Agoura Hills, and Woodland Hills, as they have been in accordance with the 1991 and 2000 redistricting plans.

The Santa Monica Mountains, a unique wildland / urban interface, create an essential bond of common interest among these communities.
