
Hollywood Hills West Neighborhood Council, one of the City of Los Angeles' certified neighborhood councils, discussed the Boundary Review Commission's work during our May 18, 2011 HHWNC meeting. Specifically, we focused on whether the Commission should redraw the Third Supervisorial District in any significant manner following the 2010 US Census.

The following motion was made regarding this issue:

(Feldman/_____) moved, "Following every federal census such as the 2010 US Census, the County Board of Supervisors' districts are evaluated and redrawn. Given that the Third Supervisorial District includes the area from Malibu to Griffith Park, including the bulk of the San Fernando Valley, all of the Santa Monica Mountains' hillside communities and downtown Hollywood, the Hollywood Hills West Neighborhood Council recommends to the County's boundary Review Commission that (i) the third Supervisorial District's borders should be left intact as much as possible, and (ii) the HHWNC's entire area should stay in the Third Supervisorial District. The Third Supervisorial District is a cohesive, compact area which aligns our HHWNC's interests and concerns with those of most of our neighboring communities, including West Hollywood, Studio City and North Hollywood, which are included in the Third Supervisorial District.

The motion carried unanimously.
