

I strongly support keeping the Palos Verdes Peninsula and the City of Rolling Hills as part of the Fourth Supervisorial District of Los Angeles County, in the final outcome of the redistricting process.

We do not want to see our South Bay neighborhoods, communities and cities divided into separate districts. The Fourth District boundaries, as currently drawn, should be maintained as much as possible. Split communities could result in changes to the service quality and timeliness we have come to expect from the County and require the Supervisorial Staffs to learn new neighborhoods and new local concerns and issues.
