**SUBJECT: COMMENTS ON LOS ANGELES COUNTY SUPERVISORIAL
REDISTRICTING**

La Mirada has been represented by the Fourth District for a number of years, and I request the City of La Mirada remain in the Fourth Supervisorial District.

The City of La Mirada is a vibrant community in Southeast Los Angeles County, and we work closely with neighboring cities on significant economic, transportation, and environmental quality projects distinctive to our region.

We have existing partnerships with other cities in the Fourth District including Norwalk, Downey, Commerce, Whittier, Cerritos and others in the Gateway Cities region, which are mostly represented by the Fourth District. Having the same supervisorial representation with our regional partners is extremely helpful in accomplishing our shared endeavors.
