Dear Mr. Pedersen:

For the past two decades the boundary lines of the districts for County Supervisors have remained relatively unchanged, adjusted primarily for shifts in population to achieve equal balance.

This system has worked well to protect the interests of citizens residing within these Supervisorial districts, and for the most part common interests have been protected within these boundaries to the benefit of constituents.

As a long time resident and business operator in Marina del Rey, I am keenly aware that unincorporated Marina del Rey has always been represented successfully and efficiently by the elected officials and their staffs in the Fourth District.

Marina del Rey is an exceptional community that was created by the combination of private investment and government participation. It is very different from the coastal communities to the north, including Venice, Santa Monica and Malibu, none of which have marinas or significant boating opportunities.

Because Marina del Rey has its own harbor, marine-related businesses and recreational boating activities, it has more in common with other South Bay coastal cities such as Redondo Beach as well as San Pedro and Long Beach, all of them located in the Fourth District and that also have marinas and boating-related businesses.

It only makes sense from a standpoint of geography and commonality of interests that Marina del Rey should remain in the Fourth District, along with all coastal cities to the south, all the way to the Orange County line.

Please consider maintaining the integrity of the southern coastal communities that should remain in the Fourth District as the result of the redistricting.
