to whom It May concern,

My name is Jay Cramer. I broke my neck 6 years ago in a rock climbing accident. After a 41-day stay in the ICU at UCLA I was transferred to Rancho Los Amigos National Rehabilitation Center. It was this transfer that changed my life for the better forever. The doctors, nurses, therapists and staff at Rancho saved my life in every way a person's life could be saved. Because of Rancho, I have been lucky enough to regain total independence. My life is better now than it was before the accident.

I have reviewed several maps and am concerned that the Boundary Review Committee may take Rancho out of Supervisor Knabe's district. This would be detrimental to patients at Rancho. Rancho needs to stay in Supervisor Knabe's district. As a person with a disability, I am part of a community of interest.

Supervisor Knabe is the only Supervisor that voted to keep Rancho open. I feel if another Supervisor takes over Rancho, that Supervisor will not support us like Supervisor Knabe.

Thank you for considering my testimony and for your consideration to keep Rancho with Supervisor Knabe.
