To the Boundary Review Committee,

I am a long time resident of Altadena, having lived here for over 25 years. Altadena is a cohesive community, with a Town Council, a Library District, three water companies, our own written history (*Altadena: Between Wilderness and City*), and non-profits devoted to the betterment of Altadena (e.g., Altadena Heritage, Altadena Historical Society). Although we are not an incorporated town, Altadena should be considered and treated as such for the purpose of setting district boundaries. Therefore, as Supervisorial district boundaries are crafted, I request that

1. Altadena remain in one supervisorial district;
2. Altadena remain with the cities with which it shares a common school district, namely Pasadena and Sierra Madre;
3. Altadena remain in District 5.

Altadena must not be split among different Districts to satisfy any need to makeup or balance population or racial characteristics. Being governed by one Supervisor ensures that this community remain whole and cohesive as a community.

Thank you for your diligent work on behalf of Los Angeles County in undertaking this task.
