I have been informed that there is the possibility of redistricting parts or all of the unincorporated City of Altadena resulting in Supervisor Michael Antonovich no longer being our representative.

We strongly oppose this move and feel that it is very ill-advised. Not only does Sup. Antonovich understand the issues that Altadena faces, based on his years invested in the community, but he has been a solid supporter of our sheriff, the Altadena Library, our schools, and has shown leadership in continuing the investigating the recent disastrous Station Fire.
