Resolutions, 4/14/2021

(R1) The LA County CRC advocates amending Elections Code § 21534(c)(3) as follows:

- (3) After the commission draws a draft map, the commission shall do both of the following:  
(A) Post the map for public comment on the internet website of the County of Los Angeles.  
(B) Conduct at least two public hearings to take place over a period of no fewer than ~~30~~ten days.

In addition, the LA County CRC would support similarly amending the equivalent mandate of the County of San Diego Independent Redistricting Commission. (Elections Code § 21552(c)(3).)

(R2) The LA County CRC advocates setting February 14, 2022, in law as the map adoption deadline for this decade's local redistricting. (That date is currently the Calif. CRC's current map adoption deadline, based on a Calif. Supreme Court ruling and a U.S. Census Bureau announcement.)

(R3) The LA County CRC supports postponing the primary election day currently scheduled for June 7, 2022, to a later date, as a method of allowing more time for redistricting, if doing so would not interfere with proper administration of the general election scheduled for November 2022.

(R4) If state law will not be amended to set a date certain as the map adoption deadline for this decade's redistricting, the LA County CRC suggests amending Elections Code § 21501(a) as follows:

(a) (1) For redistricting occurring in 2031 and thereafter, the boundaries of the supervisorial districts shall be adopted by the board not later than 205 days before the county's next regular election occurring after January 1 in each year ending in the number two.

(2) For redistricting occurring before 2031 and where a county has a regular election occurring after January 1, 2022, ~~and before July 1, 2022,~~ the boundaries of the supervisorial districts shall be adopted by the board not later than 174 days before that election. Notwithstanding subdivision (b) of Section 8106, the forms required under that subdivision shall not be made available until at least 28 days after the adoption of a final map. The elections official shall reduce the required number of signatures for the in-lieu-filing-fee petition, as specified in subdivision (a) of Section 8106, by the same proportion as the reduction in time for the candidate to collect signatures.

~~(3) For redistricting occurring before 2031 and where a county does not have a regular election occurring after January 1, 2022 and before July 1, 2022, the boundaries of the supervisorial districts shall be adopted by the board not later than 205 days before the county's next regular election occurring on or after July 1, 2022.~~

(R5) The LA County CRC advocates amending Elections Code § 21534(c)(4)(B) as follows:

(B) Notwithstanding Section 54954.2 of the Government Code, the commission shall post the agenda for the public hearings described in paragraphs (2) and (3) at least ~~seven~~ five days before the hearings. The agenda for a meeting required by paragraph (3) shall include a copy of the draft map.

In addition, the LA County CRC would support similarly amending the equivalent mandate of the County of San Diego Independent Redistricting Commission. (Elections Code § 21552(c)(4)(B).)
