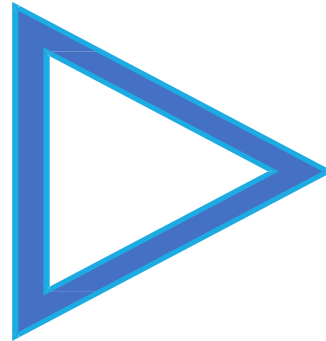

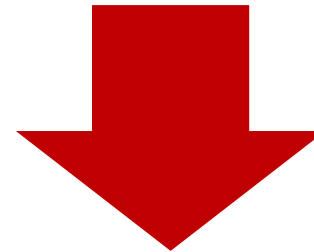

Communities of Interest (COI) Google Form

The Commission wants to know four key things from you about your community:

- 1. The economic and social interests that bind your community together**
- 2. Why your community should be kept together for fair and effective representation**
- 3. Where your community is located**
- 4. What nearby areas do they want to or not want to be grouped with**

While there are no clear rules on how to define a community of interest, here are some ways to describe your community.

1. Begin with your city or unincorporated area: Mention the street names and significant locations in your neighborhood to help identify the parameters of your community.
2. What are your shared interests?
3. What brings you together?
4. What is important to your community?
5. Are there nearby areas you want to be in a district with?
6. Nearby areas you don't want to be in a district with? Why or why not?
7. Has your community come together to advocate for important services, better schools, roads, or health centers in your neighborhood?

Order for oral public comments for Zone F:

1. Individuals who complete the COI Google Form with zip codes in Zone F
90022; 90040; 90601; 90602; 90603; 90604;
90605; 90606; 90631; 90640; 90660
2. Individuals from other communities of interest not covered by zip codes but completed the COI Google Form
3. Any other individuals, enter into QA:
 - Your name and community of interest
4. Individuals who call in

- LA County will be providing free mapping software for redistricting – targeted for mid-August; however, Census data not available until late August.

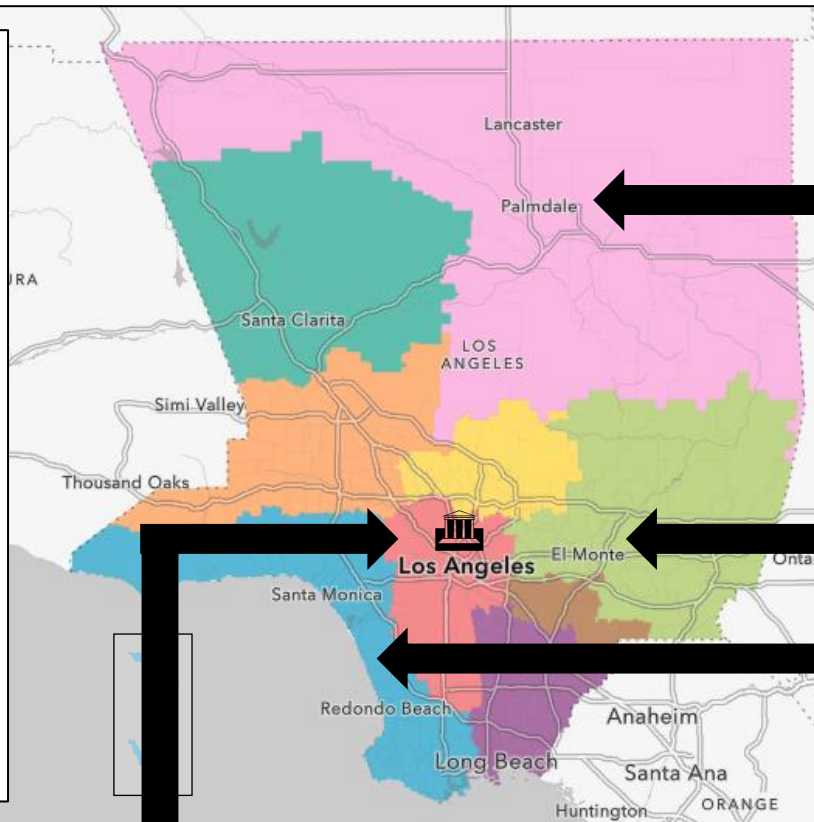

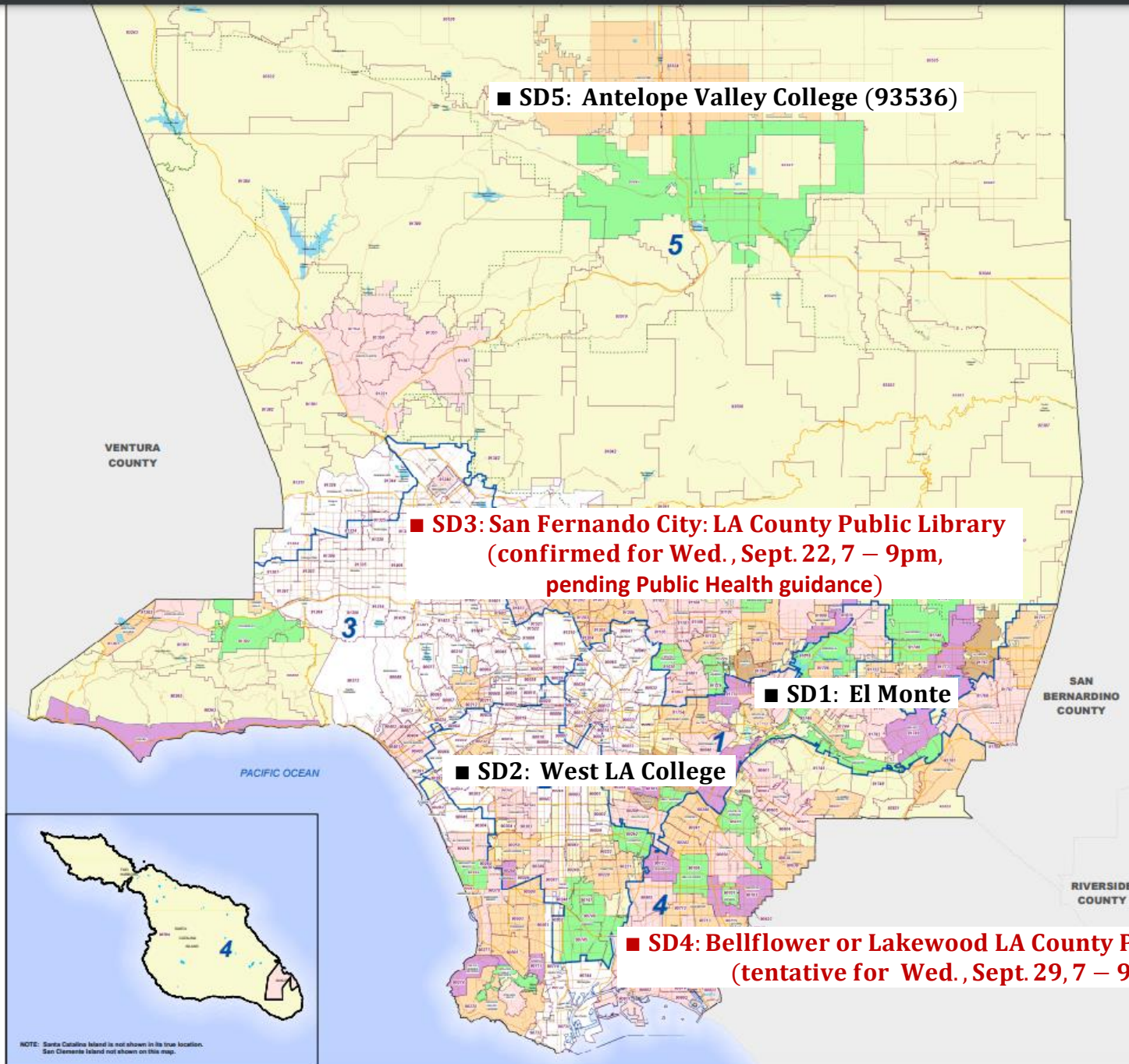
