**Background:** A community of interest is a contiguous population that shares common social and economic interests that should be included within a single district for purposes of its effective and fair representation. Communities of interest shall not include relationships with political parties, incumbents, or political candidates.

This public hearing is the 12<sup>th</sup> of 12 scheduled public hearings for COI input. The hybrid meeting is being held in Supervisorial District to ensure at least one hybrid meeting has been held in each of the 5 Supervisorial Districts during the COI public hearing phase.

**Background:** Recently passed legislation allows legislative bodies to continue to conduct teleconference meetings after September 30 if certain criteria are met and findings made. This item is to consider adopting a formal resolution that includes specific findings regarding health and safety issues. Such resolution would permit the LA County CRC to conduct its anticipated October 6, 2021, meeting virtually as





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well as meetings within the following 30 days. The LA County CRC will need to re-adopt such findings at least every 30 days to enable the resolution to continue in effect.
