



**Los Angeles County Citizens Redistricting Commission
Ad Hoc Working Group on Map F (Now OP 065)**

Ad Hoc Working Group Process

The Commissioners came prepared with completed worksheets of *specific* suggested changes and their reasoning. The Commissioners used a round-robin approach to be efficient and fair to all Commissioners' input, following this process:

1. Commissioner suggested a change to assigned draft map options (Option B-1 or Option F).
2. Thai V. Le made the changes to the assigned draft map option via redistricting mapping software.
3. All other attending Commissioners raised their hands to provide questions, comments, support, or opposition.
4. The Commissioner making suggested changes responded to questions and concerns, then made any adjusted recommendations to the original suggestion.
5. If there is a consensus, Thai V. Le proceeded to make changes to draft map options via redistricting mapping software.
6. Gayla Kraetsch Hartsough recorded changes made and the reasoning for the changes in a shared document.
7. If there is not a consensus, the Ad Hoc Working Group moved to the next Commissioner's suggestion.

Concepts and Overall Observations Discussed

The Ad Hoc Working Group for Map F built on the Commissioners’ adjustments made to Map F at the special meeting on November 22, 2021.

Ad Hoc WG’s Observations:

- Keep cities and unincorporated areas together as much as possible
- LA City NCs can be addressed later
- Look at the socio-economic map layer when considering communities with similar interests and challenges

Other observations and proposed macro changes:

- Montebello and Commerce with East LA should be together -- share issues with toxic waste
- East LA has a dense population so has major impact on the size of SD; students attend LAUSD schools
- In contrast, keep SELA together; SELA public input wants to be in SD 1
- SFV -- shift NE (Sylmar, San Fernando, Sun Valley) to be part to SD 5; shift western part (Woodland Hills) to be part of SD 3
