Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ AAPI & AMEMSA Redistricting Collaborative includes COIs in Chinatown, Little Tokyo, Koreatown, Historic Filipino Town, Thai Town, the San Gabriel Valley, Gardena, Torrance, Carson, and West Carson ▪ Check these maps to ensure all residences in Eagle Rock, north of Colorado Blvd and south of 134 freeway, are included; keep zip code 90041 in one SD. Stated that south of the 134 is Eagle Rock and north of the 134 is Glendale ▪ In the case of Hawthorne, Inglewood, and Lennox, the Tongan community has a rich history of immigration. ▪ Keep Bell, Bell Gardens, Commerce, Cudahy, Huntington Park, Lynwood, Maywood, South Gate, and Vernon together ▪ Keep Chinatown and Little Tokyo together ▪ Keep Lynwood, Cudahy, Commerce, Vernon, Huntington Park, Maywood, Bell, Bell Gardens and South Gate ▪ Keep SELA communities and Florence Firestone together ▪ Little Tokyo boundaries are Main Street in the west; Temple Street in the north; Vignes Street in the east to E. 1st Street, where Hewitt Street becomes the eastern border; and E. 3rd Street in the south between Main and San Pedro Streets, where E. 4th Street becomes the southern border to E. 4th Place ▪ Samoan Community in the Western Long Beach & Carson areas: Keep the City of Carson and parts of West Long Beach whole. The boundaries of the Samoan community in West Long Beach start at Anaheim St. and the 103 Hwy, moving east to Orange Ave. The boundaries continue north to the 91 Highway and West to the 710. It runs along the 710 to the 405, and includes the Westside neighborhood running along the train tracks back to the 103. ▪ SELA region include ▪ The business corridor that runs north-south along Western Ave from Gardena to Torrance remains a hub of activity and is economically significant for many Asian American businesses from restaurants and medical offices to auto body shops and various import-export companies.
